

The State of North Carolina Shelter Trailer Program

About The Program

The State of North Carolina Shelter Trailer Program offers temporary travel trailers for up to six months to eligible survivors whose homes cannot be occupied. This applies to homeowners and renters in [39 counties and the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians](#).

You may be eligible if:

- Your primary residence is located within one of the disaster-designated counties for Individual Assistance.
- You have a current FEMA registration number.
- You are a homeowner or renter.
- Your home sustained major damage from Helene and cannot be occupied.
- You are not receiving funds from FEMA for rental assistance.

What documents do I need?

- Identification (e.g., driver's license, passport, etc.)
- Proof of residency (e.g., lease, home title, voter registration card, utility bill, etc.)
- Proof of ownership or rental (e.g., deed, lease, property tax b, etc.).
- Insurance (e.g., proof of insurance or certification of no insurance)
